Skip Frey

Skip Frey has been involved with the sport of bowling off and on since he began in youth leagues in 1962. His participation included many leagues as well as helping to coach youth from 1982 to 1984. After his retirement from

Federal Service in May 2000, Skip was able to return to league bowling and continues to this day. Skip has served as a league secretary/treasurer in numerous leagues continues to serve as the Secretary/Treasurer of the Wednesday Night Men's and Tuesday Nite Mixed leagues. Skip also served as the league coordinator at Liberty Lanes from 2005 until its closing in 2017. Skip first became involved with the Greater Fredericksburg USBC Association (GFUSBCA) when , in January 2008, he was selected by the GFUSBCA Board

of Directors to be Association Manager. He continued to serve this capacity until his resignation in November 2014. During his time as Association Manager he represented the Association at numerous Virginia State Association Annual meetings and served as a delegate to the USBC Annual Meeting on three occasions. In 2011, Skip had a major role in the hosting of the VA State Annual Mixed Tournament the first time a VA State event was held in the Fredericksburg area.
