For Bowling Achievement

Rick exemplifies qualities of sportsmanship that make him a gentleman bowler.

Rick started bowling at the age of 13 in Southern California. At 16 he joined a local Junior Travel league and lead the league in average. At 17 he was invited to bowl in the Los Angeles Jr. All Star travel league. Rick bowled three years and was among the top five averages for all three years. During that time, he won three Jr. Amateur Tour titles. At age 20 he started bowling professionally locally and for short time on tour.

In 2002, he moved with his family to Fredericksburg, VA. Rick started bowling in the Rappahannock Men's league. During that season he met DJ Johnson, his long time doubles partner. They won multiple doubles titles, including The Fredericksburg Open Championship. The last 8 years Rick has averaged over 220 in multiple bowling centers. Three of those years, he average over 230.

Rick's accomplishments include twelve 11-in-a-row games, five 299 games, twenty-two 300 games (including one in a sport shot league), and sixteen 800 series.
