





10th ANNUAL GFUSBC WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

- ATTIRE: members are requested to wear suitable attire when participating in the GFUSBC Women's Championship tournament – no Spandex or short shorts please.
- ELIGIBILITY: All entrants in the GFUSBC Women's Championship tournament must be female members of the USBC and the Greater Fredericksburg USBC Association. Unmarried grade and high school students who have not yet attained the age of 18 must provide written consent signed by their parent or guardian.
- ENTERING AVERAGE: Entrants shall use their USBC 2013-14 composite average. If the entrant does not have a 2013-14 composite average they would use the following:
- Highest current league average for 21 or more games as of December 31, 2014.*
- (2) Use a scratch average of 210.

*Current league averages must be supported by an Average Verification form with the league secretary's signature and supporting bowler history

NOTE: Entrants using a December 31" average must use highest league average she has participated in regardless if bowled as a regular member or a substitute. (See back page for clarification.)

- 4. GENERAL AVERAGE RULES. The following rules are waived: USBC Rule 319.a.2 (current average 10 pins higher than last year), USBC Rule 319d (reporting prize winnings) and USBC Rule 319e (re-rate) are waived. Uncertified league averages are not valid.
- a. It is the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether submitted by the bowler, their captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than the correct average, resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. Average corrections must be submitted in writing within 48 hours after completion of the first event bowled.
- b. Emergency substitutes without a verified average may bowl using a 210 average. Written verification of average will be due within seven days of the bowling date in order to correct average, handicap, and classification.

CHECK IN: Team captains must check in no later than ONE HOUR prior to bowling time and present USBC cards of all team members. Doubles and Singles entrants must check in no later than ½ HOUR before the scheduled bowling time.

- EMERGENCIES: No change will be made in the entrant's scheduled time of bowling after January 4, 2015 except for an emergency. The Tournament Director must approve all changes to the schedule.
- 6. ENTRY FEE: The entry fee is \$25.00 per person per event Team, Doubles & Singles \$9.00 lineage, \$13.50 prize fund, and \$2.50 expense fee. Handicap All Events fee (optional) will be \$5.00: \$4.50 Prize Fund; .50 Expense Fee. Scratch All Events fee (optional) will be \$5.00: \$4.50 Prize Fund; .50 Expense Fee. (All Events fees may be transferred to another bowler providing the transfer is made before either bowler has participated in any event.)

FULL FEES FOR DOUBLES MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES. (YOU MUST SEND FEES FOR EITHER 2 OR 4 PEOPLE FOR DOUBLES.) PARTIAL ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

After entries have been scheduled, no fees will be refunded unless a refusal of scheduling has been received by the GFUSBC Women's Championship Tournament Director within seven (7) days of the date of notification, or no later than January 4, 2015.

Entry fees may be remitted by Personal Check - All applicable bank fees will be charged for any personal checks returned by the bank. Overpayments of less than \$1 will not be refunded.

 HANDICAP: The tournament shall be in two divisions and shall be handicapped at 90% of the difference of individual average and 210 based on three games.

The two divisions of the tournament, by average, are:

	Div 1	Div 2
Team	620 & up	619 & under
Doubles	310 & up	309 & under
Singles & All Events	155 & up	154 & under

8. MULTIPLE ENTRIES: Multiple entries will be allowed in <u>Singles, Doubles and Team Events</u>, provided there is a change of at least two (2) team members in the <u>Team Event and one (1) person in the Doubles Event</u>. An individual may place multiple times in the <u>Team and Doubles Events</u>, but only once in the Singles Event. The first series bowled in each event will count towards all-events.

9. PRIZES: Prize money will be returned 100%. Prize money shall be <u>sent to the</u> team captain within 30 days after the tournament ends. The team captain shall distribute the prize money within 30 days of receipt. Prize checks will be void 90 days after the date of issuance.

All of the cash awards will be paid on a handicap basis with the exception of the optional Scratch All Events. Prizes will be paid on a ratio of at least one prize for each ten entries. All Events will be paid on a ratio of at least 1 in 20. Each division champion will receive a trophy. In the event of a tie for championship, Cochampions' will be declared and prize money will be divided equally and duplicate awards will be presented. The bowler who places first in the handicap all-events shall be entitled to the title and trophy (regardless if she has not paid the optional all-events fee).

10. SUBSTITUTIONS: If a scheduled entrant cannot participate, a substitute may be used, providing she is not in violation of the multiple entry rule. Substitutions, along with average verification must be reported at least ONE HOUR BEFORE bowling time to the Tournament Director. The substitute shall take the place in the line-up of the original entrant. A substitute replacing a bowler who entered in all-events shall be entered in all-events shall be entered in all-events automatically provided she replaces the original bowler in all three events and provided transfer of all-events has not been otherwise designated. The original bowler will forfeit the right to bowl in the event for the original scheduled time.

In case of disability after a game has started, a substitute will be permitted in team and doubles, the combined score to count. In the case a tardy bowler arrives after a substitute has bowled, the substitute shall complete the series in progress. When the Division changes because of a substitution in mid-game, the team or doubles shall be classified into the highest Division for the event.

11. TARDINESS: A player arriving late shall begin play with the frame in progress, except if a substitute is bowling for her. If a substitute has been used, the original bowler will forfeit the right to bowl in that event at that time.

A bowler who misses one frame or more by not being present and ready to bowl when it is her turn shall not be credited with any pins for frames missed.

12. OTHER:

Bowlers entering singles must also enter doubles and vice versa.

The Doubles event will be bowled first

8 minutes of practice will be permitted.

Telescores will be used as the official scores.

Singles & Doubles will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.

Pacers are not permitted.

... The use of such substances as talcum powder, pumice, resin, etc., on shoes, or the use of soft rubber soles and heels that rub off and in any manner may alter the normal conditions of the approach, is strictly prohibited.

- 13. PROTESTS: Protests concerning eligibility or general playing rules must be conveyed in writing to the Tournament Director before prize payments are made. Any dispute or disagreement shall be immediately referred to and decided by the Tournament Director. A score sheet cannot be changed after the official scorer, captain or entrant has signed it, except that obvious errors in scoring, handicap, and classification may be corrected by a tournament official.
- DECISIONS: All decisions of the Tournament Director are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
