Interviews taken during Fred City Strikers league with coaches/parents



Eric Brown Eric is an Orbital Analyst Supervisor at Dahlgren. His group provides Collision Avoidance for the International Space Station. How cool is that?! 21 years ago, Eric was dragged into bowling by his wife (Dawn). Now, he bowls at AMF Fredericksburg on the Merchant's Mixed, the Friday Nite Early, the Monday Master's league and subs at

Liberty lanes in the Wednesday Night Men's league. He currently has a 223 average with lifetime high yearbook average of 218. Eric's high series is an 812 and he currently has bowled four (4) 300 games, 2 at AMF Fredericksburg and 2 at Liberty Lanes. He bowls in Local tournaments, Association Tournaments, and National Tournaments. His most memorable moment was bowling an 11in-a-row in a state tournament. He follows the PBA and his favorite pro bowler is Walter Ray Williams III. He admits that he also like Liz Johnson, who he got to meet in Buffalo during a youth tournament. When not bowling, Eric coaches youth leagues. He has been coaching for 11 years. When asked about his own bowling. He says he is practicing on Sundays with Bryan Gallahan working on his hand and arm position during his release. He is also working on his mental focus during the last game as he feels that is his weak point.



Ashley Couture Ashley is an IRS Revenue Officer. Her mother introduced her to bowling as a small child. Her whole family bowled, so it was just natural that she picked it up. Ashley bowls at AMF Fredericksburg on the Friday Nite Early, and on Tuesday on the Merchant's Mixed league. She currently has a 138 average with lifetime high

yearbook average of 145. Her high game is 279 and she believes her high series is 502. Ashley's most memorable event was truly memorable. She was competing in the USBC Open Tournament in Reno, NV. She bought a new ball there and it was a little tight on her thumb. Early in the event, her thumb stuck in the ball. The ball sailed 10 feet in the air, and came down with a resounding boom. She was at the foul line and almost the entire stadium stopped and looked at her. On a good note, her embarrassment was not as bad as the guy bowling across from her, though. His entire team was giving him a hard time because he was getting beat by a woman. She doesn't plan to embarrass herself for much longer. Her husband is a bowler and plans to get her a more aggressive ball with finger tip drilling and make her practice more.



Dawn Brown Dawn is a Configuration Management Analyst at BAE Systems. Dawn's Mother started her in bowling duck pin bowling when she was 5 years old. She started been bowling Tenpin bowling in 1992. Now, Dawn bowls at AMF Fredericksburg on the Friday Nite Early, and subs on the Merchant's Mixed league. She currently has a 173 average with lifetime high yearbook average of

184. She doesn't know what her high game or series is. She doesn't have any illusions of bowling a 300 game. She says she gets shaky when she has 5 in a row and said that if she had an 8 bagger, she would probably throw up. However, nerves don't keep Dawn from bowling in Association, State, and National Tournaments. Dawn says she doesn't really like to think about her bowling. Her husband (Eric) had to drag her into a finger tip ball and a proper release. She just wants to have fun. If she had it her way, she would use a conventional drilled ball, throw it at the head pin and see what happens. That doesn't mean that she isn't into Bowling. Dawn is currently the Vice-President of the GFUSBCA Board of Directors. Dawn is the Fred City Strikers Youth Tournament Leader. With this job she leads fundraising for the Fred City Strikers and coordinates all of events including Pepsi Qualifiers.



Isabelle Pryor When I asked Isabelle what she did for a living, she first said she doesn't work. Then she said he home schools her children and is a homemaker. That sounds like a pretty tough job to me. Isabelle's Father was a bowler, but it was her neighbor, Tony Cornell that got her into bowling. She shared her first season with another woman and they split

costs and bowling. By the end of that season, Isabelle decided that sharing time on the lanes was not for her. She wanted to bowl more. Isabelle now bowls at AMF Fredericksburg on the Tuesday Merchant's Mixed league, the Wednesday Frenzy league, and the non-sanctioned Goodtimers league. She currently has a 169 average with lifetime high yearbook average of 168. Her high game is 236 and her high series is 566. Isabelle bowls in the local no-tap and handicap tournaments along with Association and State Tournaments. She hasn't bowled in any National Tournaments, but it is on her bucket list. Isabelle is always updating her goals. Her original goal was to have her average higher than her handicap. Now with that accomplished she has a goal of 500 or better every time she bowls. She is coming close to that by working on her timing and release. She is doing it with practice and coaching.



Daryl Perdue Daryl is a Substation Technician for Rural Electric Cooperative. He bowls at Liberty center in the Wednesday Night Men's league. He also subs at AMF on the Merchant's Mixed league and the Friday Nite Early league. Daryl's mother and father were YABA coaches, and they taught him how to bowl. He is passing his bowling skills on to his son. They practice on Sundays. While his son is working on his strike game, Daryl works on his spare game. They also challenge each other to a game of low-ball. Daryl likes to bowl as a sub, because he gets to meet and bowl with new people. He does follow the PBA. His favorite male bowler is Norm Duke and his favorite female bowler is Liz Johnson. Daryl bowls in Association and State tournaments, but has not yet bowled in a national tournament. He has bowled and cashed in a PBA regional tournament. Daryl is the owner of two 300 games and one 800 series, an 813. His most memorable event was bowling 24 strikes in a row on his way to his 813 series. He is most proud of his Team first place finish in an Association Tournament.
