Greater Fredericksburg USBCA Hall of Fame Selection Committee Guidelines

The Committee will normally be made up of two HOF Committee Members per HOF Operating Procedures; however, they may add additional members to help with their task. Additional members must be non-voting participants.

- This committee will begin advertising the nominating process and time frames to Association Members no later than August 1 of the nominating year. The following are suggested methods for circulating this information:
 - News letter
 - Flyers
 - o AMF Center Scroll Bar
 - Mass email by web site coordinator
 - GFUSBCA Web site page
 - GFUSBCA Face book

Nominations will be accepted between September 1 and October 31 of the nominating year.

Collection procedures

- All nominations must be delivered in a sealed envelope (protects anonymity) as follows:
 - o To a GFUSBCA Mailbox (Must be purchased) addressed to HOF Selection Committee
 - o Any board member (board members cannot accept unless the nomination is in a sealed envelope)

The accompanying Documents are:

- A Nomination Form which includes data about the nominee for Bowling Achievements or Meritorious Service.
- Number based rating systems for data provided on the nomination form.

Instructions for the use of the forms and rating system:

- The Selection Committee must use all means at their disposal to research and verify information provided on the nomination form.
- Per HOF Operating Procedures, no more than four candidates will be selected and presented for vote in a calendar year.
- Rules in the case of ties.*(Selection Committee would interview nominees if <u>more than four</u> nominees have the same point value)
 - The Selection Committee must develop a standard set of questions used to interview each nominee thus
 providing consistency and fairness in this process. Based on the results of these interviews, this
 committee will select the top four candidates.
- The committee will write up recommendations for each nominee on separate ballots. Ballots will not contain the name of the candidate and will be distinctly marked so only the Selection Committee will know which ballot pertains to a given nominee.
- The ballots will then be provided to the full HOF Committee who will present to the board and standing HOF members for vote.

Award Suggestions for HOF Candidates:

- Sports Jacket Men or Women (Jackets should be mandatory and will be emblazoned on the left front
 of the jacket with the GFUSBCA LOGO, the words "HALL of FAME and year achieved.), plaque, lapel
 pin, award dinner (the GFUSBCA is responsible for the inductee and immediate family dinner costs)
- It is suggested that a plaque listing hall of fame members be placed in centers served by the GFUSBCA.
