2014—2015 WINTER SEASON WRAP-UP



Hello to all my fellow GFUSBCA Bowlers. I am Don Monroe. I am the editor of the newsletter and 1st Vice-President of the GFUSBCA. This is my 3rd year of service as a board member. I took over the newsletter in September of 2014. We have added a 4th printed newsletter and 12 e-newsletters to the 3 printed newsletters. We have lowered the cost of advertising in the newsletters with \$100 for full page ads, \$50 for 1/2 page adds and \$25 for business card

sizes. The Facebook continues to grow. We have over 200 friends. I would like to double that number by the end of the year, however many of our members do not have Facebook accounts. We use Facebook for sending out invitations to tournaments, pictures of award ceremonies and other relevant news items. We have instituted Mail Chimp. This is an automated email sent to all members that have an email address. We use this on a monthly basis to send out copies of the newsletter and inform members about upcoming tournament and important association news. Of our 1400 members, we have 940 valid email addresses.

Since Brenda Chambers, President of GFUSBCA, gave the board members off from meetings in June, I have decided to give her a month off from creating a message from the president. This doesn't mean the board members are sitting on their hands. The newsletter is still being created, award criteria is be revised, Hall of Fame arrangements are being confirmed, new community service projects are being considered, lanes are being certified, and the annual League Officers workshop is being set up. In addition to this, the Association Manager is busy closing up winter leagues and certifying new summer leagues.

A coaching initiative was started for the youth going to VA State, Nationals, and Jr. Gold tournaments. There is a Saturday morning league, monitored by coaches and an hour of coaching drills to help the youth better prepare for these tournaments.

Shelby Sullivan was awarded the GFUSBCA Outstanding Service Award. Shelby assisted with every tournament the Association put on. She helped by running the Ways and Means table as well as selling raffle tickets and 50-50 tickets. She even recruited some of her friends to help during the tournaments.

We have had a turnover of officers on the board of Directors. The first was the association manager, Skip Frey, who retired after several years of outstanding service. Skip was replaced by Diana Monroe. Elections were held during the annual meeting. President Brenda Chambers is retiring after 10 years of service and George French was elected as the new President. Dawn Brown was elected as 2nd Vice president to replace the position vacated by George French. D.J. Johnson was elected as Sergeant at arms to fill the position vacated by Dawn Brown. Deberia Henningsen was elected as Adult Director to replace the position vacated by D.J. Johnson. Joshua Eggleston and Brian Eggleston were elected as Youth Directors.

In other association news, the Local Association dues were raised from \$7.00 a year to \$9.00 a year. Brenda Chambers and Jim Wolfe were elected to the GFUSBCA Hall of Fame. The induction ceremony and dinner will take place in the Fall.





Professional Women's Bowling Tour






